Most of our students have taken the two assessments yet some of our full-time distance learners have not completed the BAS (Benchmark Assessment System) and the FAST (Formative



Assessment System for Teachers). Please contact our school to schedule a time that your child will work, one on one with an adult, to complete these assessments. As they learn new information and practice the skills, we will reassess the students to monitor their growth. We know that some students will excel with distance learning and others will need more support. These assessments help us determine the needs of each student and areas where we need to modify instruction to support each student at our school.

Attendance is extremely important for academic growth and to ensure everyone's safety. Teachers are collecting this information for all students Monday - Thursday. We are required to keep this data to ensure students are participating in daily instruction and to have detailed information in the event someone tests positive for Covid-19. Please communicate with your child's teacher and our health office if your child is unable to attend.

2020-2021 will go down in history as a year to remember because VHES students learned new technology skills, safe choices, flexible thinking and patience. Thank you for supporting your children and our school!
