Dear Vadnais Heights Families,

I hope this finds you all well and enjoying the extra time at home. It's been such a strange year as we continue to address the impacts from the pandemic. There have been so many changes yet we have one thing in common at this point in time - everyone is distance learning. I am so impressed by the amazing work our staff has put in place to teach and support each and every student. I also want to thank all of our parents for the extra



support you're providing your children to be successful with online learning: setting up structures, schedules and getting them logged in for learning at home. Everything works so much better when we work together.

Please remember that we are required, as a public school, to take <u>attendance</u> every day. In order for your child to be marked "present" they need to attend daily Morning Meetings, participate in academic instruction and be engaged during small group learning sessions. If you have a conflict, please communicate with your child's teacher through Seesaw, email or a phone call. If your child needs to be absent due to illness or for other family reasons, please call our school's health office. This structure has been set up by the State of MN to support students' academic growth and we are here to help in any way possible.

Our district has set up some guidelines that will promote student success as they learn online:

- ★ Learners should be located in a place suitable for learning (ie.not in bed, not in the bathroom, etc.),
- ★ Learners should meet dress code guidelines when on a Google Meet -dress like you're going to school,
- ★ Learning space should be quiet no music, television, or other media while students are on a Google Meet to foster a positive learning environment,
- ★ Learners should ALWAYS mute their mic until they need to speak or when they are called upon,
- ★ Learner's chromebook camera should be on (we want to see your smiling faces) during Google Meets unless the teacher requests or approves the camera to be off,
- ★ Students should be **actively engaged in the lesson**...toys, pets, food/snacks and other distractions should not be present when learners are in a Google Meet,
- ★ Learners should only use the Google Meet "Chat" feature for class discussions AND the "Background" feature should be OFF,
- ★ Learners should always be respectful, responsible and follow all school rules as if they were in-person when on a Google Meet and
- ★ Family members should not involve themselves in the class Google Meet. *Eg. Family should not be on camera, give answers to your child, address the teacher during class google meet Thank You!*

This is new learning for all of us yet we will get through this together. Have a safe & wonderful holiday season!


The fundraiser was a huge success earning approximately \$9000 to support initiatives in our school. A HUGE thank you to all of our families for supporting the fall fundraiser!


